

INSTRUCTIONS FOR GOLD CROSS DYE STRIPPER

- Fill a clear enamel, stainless steel or aluminium container with sufficient water to allow the garment to float freely.
- Bring to the boil
- Add wet garment
- Continue heating and pour all or part of the contact on to the surface of the water (keeping the garment submerged to avoid direct contact with the powder.
- Stir well at the boil, until colour has faded out
- Rinse well in cold water before re-dyeing.
- Suitable for bleaching hessian and other raw fibre material

Note: Material that cannot be boiled in the wash is unsuitable for heat stripping. Stripper is not effective on polyester, terylene or vat dyed material. Contents sufficient for 1 kilogram of dry material.
